PCI for people with ACS — aspirin 75 mg in combination with either ticagrelor 90 mg twice a day, or prasugrel 10 mg daily. Clopidogrel 75 mg daily should be prescribed if prasugrel or ticagrelor are unsuitable. PCI in people with stable coronary artery disease — aspirin 75 mg daily plus clopidogrel 75 mg daily.
